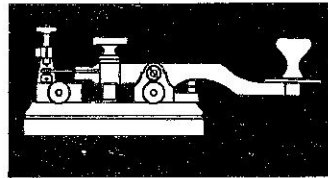


Dear Friends,


